Comments:

Crushing resumed last week after almost two weeks of lost production due to the recent wet weather. A total of 251,000 tonnes of cane was crushed last week, despite lingering showers and storms.

Factory cleans were completed at all sites while the crushing was halted. There are no stops scheduled for cleans this week.

With continuing good weather, crushing of the forecast 8.050 million-tonne crop will be completed in late November or very early December.
