#### **Comments:**

All four Burdekin mills commenced crushing operations on Tuesday 12 June. A reasonable throughput of just over 208,000 tonnes was achieved for the week.

Kalamia and Pioneer mills settled down well and crushed steadily throughout the week. Inkerman had some B-side issues early in the week but settled down towards the weekend. Invicta Mill had an extended stop on A-side to repair leaking boiler tubes.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 16.20 recorded in the Pioneer area.
