Comments:

A total of 385,000 tonnes was crushed during a week in which Inkerman, Pioneer and Invicta's A side all had scheduled stops.

The Burdekin mills passed the two million tonnes crushed mark on Friday morning and, by the end of the week, had processed around 25 per cent of the forecast crop.

CCS levels continue to rise, with the Burdekin season to date average now sitting above 14 units for the first time this season.

In the coming week, Invicta's B side will stop for a clean on Tuesday.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 17.2 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane, recorded in the Inkerman area.
