Comments:

Just over 361,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Inkerman Mill and Invicta on A side. There were also extended stoppages at both Inkerman and Invicta mills to repair failures to critical plant.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Pioneer, Kalamia and Invicta on B side.

More than 50 per cent of the district's forecast crop has now been processed, with Wilmar's Burdekin mills achieving the milestone of four million tonnes crushed last Saturday.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.0 from a rake of KQ228 first ratoon cane, recorded in the Invicta area.
