Comments:

Just over 393,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included scheduled stops at both Inkerman and Invicta's A side.

Inkerman's scheduled stop was extended so crews could fabricate a new tail drum for the mud-ash conveyor belt, which failed shortly after start-up.

Invicta Mill passed the one million tonnes of cane crushed milestone early last week.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Pioneer, Kalamia and on Invicta B side.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.15 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane, recorded in the Pioneer area.

The Burdekin crop estimate has been revised down from 8.46 million tonnes to 8.04 million tonnes.
