Just over 393,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included scheduled stops at both Inkerman and Invicta's A side.

Inkerman's scheduled stop was extended so crews could fabricate a new tail drum for the mudash conveyor belt, which failed shortly after startup.

Invicta Mill passed the one million tonnes of cane crushed milestone early last week.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Pioneer, Kalamia and on Invicta B side.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.15 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane, recorded in the Pioneer area.

The Burdekin crop estimate has been revised down from 8.46 million tonnes to 8.04 million tonnes.
