Comments:

Just over 380,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included scheduled stops at Pioneer, Kalamia and Invicta's B side.

The Burdekin mills passed the three million tonnes crushed milestone early last week.

In the coming week there will be a scheduled stop at Invicta on A side.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.3 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane, recorded in the Invicta area.
