#### Comments:

More than 381,000 tonnes of cane were crushed by the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included scheduled stops for Invicta Mill's B-side and Kalamia Mill.

Kalamia Mill passed the one million tonnes crushed milestone last week, while the district as a whole passed the five million tonnes crushed mark.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Pioneer Mill and Invicta Mill's A-side.

Average CCS for the district remained high at 15.57.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.15 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane, recorded in the Inkerman area.

The Burdekin crop estimate has been revised down from 8.04 million tonnes to 8 million tonnes.
