The Burdekin's four mills crushed a reduced throughput of just under 345,000 tonnes of cane last week. There were scheduled stops for Pioneer Mill and Invicta Mill's A-side, as well as major stoppages at Pioneer and Invicta following blackouts caused by external sources.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Inkerman Mill and Invicta Mill's B-side.

Average CCS for the district remained high at 15.50.
