#### Comments:

The Burdekin's four mills crushed just over 354,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included scheduled stops for Kalamia, Pioneer and Invicta mills.

Average CCS for the district remained high, with 15.84 units recorded for last week. The highest CCS reading for the week was 18.30 from rakes of Q208 third ratoon cane, recorded in the Inkerman area.

This week there will be a scheduled stop at Inkerman Mill.

As we enter the final weeks of the 2018 season, I'd like to remind both residents and visitors to remain vigilant around the cane railway network.
