Comments:

The Burdekin's four mills crushed just over 329,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a scheduled stop at Inkerman Mill. There was also an extended stop at Invicta Mill to repair boiler tube leaks.

Cane supply at the four Burdekin mills was impacted last week as a result of storms, with Inkerman Mill the worst-affected by the wet weather.

Average CCS for the district remained high, with 15.50 units recorded for last week. The highest CCS reading for the week was 18.0 from rakes of Q208 first and fourth ratoon cane, recorded in the Invicta area.
