Grower Criteria

- 1. Being open minded and able to constructively debate issues;
- 2. Having a successful business or professional profile with their peers (growers, millers).
- 3. Profit Orientated information seekers, with interest in new technology and innovation;
- 4. Recognised leaders in facilitating or trialling and adopting/adapting new technology;
- 5. Have an understanding of costs, key profit drivers and causes of variation in physical and financial performance across businesses in their sector.
