QSL Market Update

The May19 sugar contract continued its downward spiral last week, trading from a high of 12.73c/lb last Monday, testing 12.00c/lb on Thursday, and then closing the week down 55 points at 12.18c/lb. This was mainly driven by speculative and

system selling, and was exacerbated by the large Mar19 expiry, delivering 1 million tonnes and curbing trade talk of first-quarter tightness.
