Crushing is now underway at all four Burdekin mills, with Invicta and Pioneer starting on Tuesday 11 June.

The factories have settled into operations, and had a combined throughput of about 269,000 tonnes for the week.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 16.5 from a rake of KQ228 first ratoon cane, recorded in the Inkerman area.

I would like to remind motorists that our cane trains are now operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week. There was an incident on the weekend in which a car collided with one of our cane trains on the Bruce Highway, just north of Brandon.

Please remember to always use caution when approaching cane railway crossings and to always give way to cane trains.
