Advance rate increase

The QSL Advance rate for the 2018-Season June payment was paid this week at 97.5%. This is an increase of 2.5% on last month's rate of 95%. Herbert River growers should note that this payment incorporates siding levies passed on by your miller. The final QSL Advance payment for the 2018 Season will be made next month once the QSL Shared Pool for the season has been finalised. Growers using QSL Direct will be able to access their Q4 and annual financial reports, which capture all payments made by QSL in the relevant period, by the end of next month. Market update for Bundaberg Next Gen



Changes ahead? Let us know

Growers with a QSL Grower Pricing Agreement (GPA) who are planning changes to their farm's operating structure, such as a farm sale, new lease or subdivision, are asked to complete a QSL Farm Sale/Lease Information Form. This

form initiates the documentation process by gathering basic information about the transaction to enable QSL to prepare the Deed of Acknowledgement and/or Deed of Novation needed to implement associated pricing transfers. While this can be done during or after the transaction, it's ideally done before the change to your farm arrangements occurs.
