Court case resolved with no appeal

QSL today reached a confidential settlement on the costs associated with Wilmar's recent unsuccessful Supreme Court action against QSL, and on that basis the matter is now resolved, with no appeal to be sought. On 10 May 2019 the Supreme Court of Queensland dismissed Wilmar's legal action against QSL relating to losses associated with the 2010 sugar production season, and awarded costs to QSL. QSL Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer Greg Beashel said today's developments mean that this case is now closed, with no appeal and no negative impact on QSL's current or future pool returns.

Sugar prices surged last Friday, breaking the 12c/lb handle for the first time in three weeks. The Jul19 contract made its low on Tuesday at 11.60c/lb before peaking on Friday at 12.13c/lb, closing last week at 12.10c/lb. Speculators covering short positions, as well as trade house suspicions around a smaller-than-expected Jul19 delivery were among the reasons prices went up.
