Weekly throughput was just over 368,000 tonnes, in a week that included scheduled stops at Kalamia, Inkerman and Invicta B side.

The Burdekin mills have now crushed more than one million tonnes of cane for the season, reaching the milestone on Friday 28 June.

In the coming week there will be scheduled stops at Invicta on Tuesday, on A side, and Pioneer on Thursday

The highest CCS sample for the week was 17.55 from a rake of Q183 of first ratoon cane, recorded in the Pioneer area.

Please be alert when approaching all cane railway crossings. Cane trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
