2022-Season pricing now available

QSL is now accepting grower pricing orders for the 2022 Season.

Growers marketing with QSL can now also access additional pricing tonnages for the 2020 and 2021 Seasons. GEI Sugar pricing limits for forward seasons are:

- 2020 Season: Up to 60% of your GEI Sugar estimate
- 2021 Season: Up to 50% of your GEI Sugar estimate
- 2022 Season: Up to 40% of your GEI Sugar estimate

Final 2018-Season Payment

QSL will make its final Advances payment for the 2018 Season next week. This payment is expected to be made **one working day** later than growers' usual QSL Advance payments. Any 2019-Season Advance payments due next week will be made in a separate deposit as per the usual QSL Advances payment timing. 
Herbert River: Cane competition
