July19 roll amount confirmed

The July 2019 roll amount has now been confirmed at \$1.22 and has been applied to any 2019 Target Price Contract pricing which remained unfilled after the roll deadline of 20 June 2019. The 2019-Season Target Price Contract price now reflects a whole-of-season weighted average in a 3:2:1 ratio across the remaining October 2019, March 2020 and May 2020 ICE 11 contracts. 
Market Snapshot
