Important Information for Landowners June 2019

The Infrastructure Group [TIG] is working to help ensure safe movements of both landowner and project traffic around our work areas.

Currently, TIG is using two UHF channels for the project as follows:


- UHF 10 for works on the Bruce Highway north of Woodstock Giru Rd
- UHF 13 for works on the Bruce Highway south of Woodstock Giru Rd.

It will greatly assist safe movements if you could contact TIG traffic controllers via the appropriate UHF channel to advise that your vehicles (ie. wide loads, cane haulage tractors, etc) are entering the highway.

This request also applies to pilots, etc escorting wide loads, as TIG does not monitor UHF 40 within the project limits.

This way we can assist your movement through the work area with minimal delays to you, other road users and the project.
