Comments:

Close to 382,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included scheduled stops at Inkerman and Pioneer mills.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 17.7 from a rake of Q240 plant cane recorded in the Pioneer area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Invicta B-Side on Thursday (8 August).

The Burdekin crop estimate has been revised down from 8.24 million tonnes to 7.98 million tonnes.

Members of the public are reminded to take care as they approach all cane rail crossings. Our cane trains continue to operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
