Comments:

A total throughput of 384,292 tonnes of cane was achieved by the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Invicta on B-side.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 17.85 from a rake of Q240 plant cane recorded in the Invicta area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Inkerman Mill on Thursday (15 August).

More than 37 per cent of the district's forecast crop has now been processed, with Wilmar's Burdekin mills achieving the milestone of three million tonnes crushed in the early hours of Sunday morning (11 August).

CCS continues to rise with the cool dry weather, and the season-to-date CCS nudged past 14 units for the first time this crushing season.
