Comments:

More than 370,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Inkerman Mill.

Invicta Mill crews carried out chemical cleans on both A and B sides during an extended stop to reinstate B-side diffuser chains.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 17.6 from a rake of Q232 first ratoon cane recorded in the Pioneer area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Pioneer Mill on Tuesday (20 August).

Please remember to use your train brain when approaching cane railway crossings. Cane trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and cannot come to a quick stop.

Approach all cane railway crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
