The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.0 from a rake of Q208 fourth ration cane recorded in the Pioneer area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Inkerman Mill on Thursday (05 September).

The Burdekin mills passed the 4 million tonnes crushed milestone and the halfway mark for the season late last week.
