#### Comments:

Just over 378,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Kalamia Mill.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.0 from a rake of Q208 fourth ratoon cane recorded in the Pioneer area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Inkerman Mill on Thursday (05 September).

The Burdekin mills passed the 4 million tonnes crushed milestone and the halfway mark for the season late last week.

Please be alert when approaching all cane railway crossings. Cane trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
