Just below 379,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Pioneer Mill and Invicta A side.

In a week of milestones, Inkerman, Kalamia and Pioneer mills passed the one million tonnes of cane crushed for the season.

The weekly average CCS for the district remains high at 15.64 units while the season to date average has reached 14.5 units.

The highest CCS sample for the week was 18.8 from a rake of Q240 third ration cane recorded in the Invicta area.

This week, there are scheduled stops planned for Kalamia Mill on Tuesday (17 September) and Invicta on B-Side on Thursday (19 September).
