**Comments:**

Just over 374,000 tonnes of cane were crushed across the Burdekin's four mills in a week that included a scheduled stop at Kalamia Mill and Invicta B side.

The Burdekin mills passed the 5 million tonnes crushed milestone early last week.

The highest CCS sample was 18.1 from a rake of Q183 second ratoon cane recorded in the Inkerman area.

This week, there are scheduled stops planned for Inkerman Mill and Invicta on A-Side on Thursday (26 September).

With the commencement of school holidays, parents are asked to remind their children of the dangers associated with cane trains.

Children should stay well away from the tracks, points, locos and cane bins.
