<p>The Burdekin's four mills crushed just under 281,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a scheduled stop at Inkerman Mill. Extended stops at Invicta and Pioneer mills also contributed to the reduced weekly throughput.</p> <p>Invicta Mill passed the 2 million tonnes crushed milestone early last week.</p> <p>The highest CCS sample was 18.4 from a rake of Q240 plant cane recorded in the Pioneer area.</p> <p>This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Invicta on B-Side on Thursday (3 October).</p> <p>Members of the public are reminded to take care as they approach all cane rail crossings. Our cane trains continue to operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week.</p> <p>Parents and guardians are also urged to remind children to stay well away from our cane rail network this school holiday period.</p>
