## Comments:

The Burdekin's four mills crushed just under 378,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a scheduled stop at Invicta Mill on A-side.

There was a fire in the bagasse conveyor system at Pioneer Mill on Saturday evening, which brought a halt to crushing operations.

The highest CCS sample was 18.4 from a rake of Q240 plant cane recorded in the Invicta area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Kalamia Mill on Thursday (10 October).

The Burdekin crop estimate has been revised down from 7.98 million tonnes to 7.90 million tonnes.

We have just wrapped an incident-free school holiday period on our cane rail network, and we thank everyone for their efforts in this regard.
