Comments:

The Burdekin's four mills crushed just under 280,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a scheduled stop at Kalamia Mill. Pioneer Mill was not operational due to ongoing repairs following a fire in the bagasse conveyor system.

Pioneer Mill cane is being transferred to our three other mills. This will continue until the mill resumes crushing early next week.

The highest CCS sample was 18.0 from a rake of Q183 second ratoon recorded in the Kalamia area.

This week, there is a scheduled stop planned for Inkerman Mill and Invicta Mill's B-side on Tuesday (15 October). There is a scheduled stop for Invicta Mill's A-side on Thursday (17 October).

The Burdekin mills passed the 6 million tonnes crushed milestone early last week.
