Comments:

The Burdekin's four mills crushed just over 306,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included scheduled stops at Inkerman Mill and Invicta Mill's A and B sides.

Pioneer Mill re-commenced crushing operations on Friday evening following an extended stop due to a fire in the bagasse conveyor system on 5 October. It was a great outcome to have the factory up and running four days earlier than originally forecast.

The highest CCS sample was 18.2 from a rake of Q183 fourth ratoon recorded in the Invicta area.

There is a scheduled stop planned for Invicta's A-side on Thursday, 24 October.

With no further rain, the last day of **crushing** at each mill is forecast to be:
