- We are making good headway with transferring Pioneer burnt cane to our other north-bank mills for processing.
- The last of the Pioneer burnt cane in bins and paddocks will be in six-tonne bins, heading to Invicta or Kalamia mills by Saturday morning.
- From tomorrow (Friday), we will begin moving fresh cane out of the Pioneer Mill area and into our Invicta, Kalamia and Inkerman mills.
- Tomorrow's fresh cane target for the Pioneer area is around 2200 tonnes. This will increase to about 5000 tonnes a day over the weekend.
- We expect to be in a position to transfer higher daily volumes from early next week.
- We have put plans in place to ensure all harvesting groups at Pioneer have access to some bins while Pioneer Mill is under repair.
- Our Pioneer logistics team will contact harvesting groups directly to make arrangements.
