Key dates for grower-managed pricing

Individual Futures Contract & Self-Managed Harvest: 15 June

15 June 2020 is the Pricing Completion Date for growers using QSL's Individual Futures Contract (IFC) and/or Self-Managed Harvest (SMHP) pricing products.

Growers with unfilled IFC or SMHP orders against the July 2020 ICE 11 Contract after this date will have their orders priced by QSL at the next market opportunity. For more details about the IFC, please <u>click here</u>. You can find details regarding the SMHP by <u>clicking here</u>.

Target Price Contract: 22 June

22 June 2020 is the last day for growers using the QSL Target Price Contract to achieve 2020-Season targets before any unpriced tonnes are transferred (rolled) into the next contract and roll costs may apply. To see the latest indicative roll adjustment, please <u>click here</u>.
