Comments:

Crushing resumed at Invicta Mill about midnight Thursday following a week-long wet weather stop.

The weather was cool and windy throughout the week, providing good drying conditions. However, ground conditions remained too wet in the other three mill areas to ensure a continuous supply.

Any cane that was able to be cut in those areas was sent to Invicta for processing.

Total throughput of just over 46,000 tonnes was achieved for the week. Cane quality was good.

The highest CCS sample was 16.4 from a rake of Q183 first ratoon cane in the Invicta area.

The opportunity was taken to complete steam off works at all mills during the wet weather shutdown.

Crushing operations are expected to resume at our other three mills this week.
