Comments:

The Burdekin recorded good throughput for week 10, with more than 395,000 tonnes crushed across the four mills.

This was above budget, despite unscheduled stops at Pioneer and Inkerman mills.

Average weekly CCS is climbing steadily and finished the week at 14.31 units.

The highest CCS of 17.3 was shared three ways from a rake of Q240 plant and Q240 first ratoon in the Pioneer area and a rake of Q183 plant in the Inkerman area.

The crop continues to yield close to the original forecast in tonnes but CCS remains slightly below budget due to the persistent wet conditions.
