Latest Burdekin Agriculture News

A new \$520 000 jumbo greenhouse at the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF) Ayr Research Station is ready to unlock new high-value markets for tropical agribusiness.

The 900 m² retractable roof greenhouse is the cornerstone of protected cropping research by the Agri-Science Queensland team. The work undertaken at the site will contribute to development of export markets for high-value crops including capsicum, tomato, specialty melon and eggplant.

Regional growers will be able to inspect the greenhouse and its crops once the trials are up and running.

Queensland is at the forefront of protected cropping research, development and extension (RD&E) in the tropics and subtropics, with Hort Innovation recently engaging DAF to develop a national RD&E strategy in consultation with stakeholder groups, to drive future investment in the technologies.





EDMG Update

The Export Market Development Grant (EMDG) program has undergone an independent review with Minister Birmingham announcing reform of the EMDG program to cut red tape, increase awareness of the scheme and give exporters more funding certainty.

AUSVEG and the Export Council of
Australia (ECA) have recently launched
a new online e-learning training program
for aspiring vegetable exporters. The
Export Fundamentals for Australian Fruit
& Vegetable Growers: From Farmgate to
International Markets course contains 11
self-paced e-learning modules covering
a broad range of topics relating to
international trade for fresh produce.

This online training program is suitable for vegetable growers not currently involved in export, vegetable growers who do export but want to improve their export knowledge, and experienced vegetable exporting businesses who want to develop the practical export skills of staff members.

Queensland Monsoon Trough, 25 January - 14 February 2019, you may be eligible for a North Queensland Restocking, Replanting & On-farm Infrastructure Grant to assist with further recovery.

About this grant scheme

Grants of up to \$400,000 are available to eligible primary enterprises for:

- · Restocking lost livestock;
- Replanting lost or damaged crops or permanent plantings;
- Restoring or replacing lost or damaged on-farm infrastructure.
