Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 380,000 tonnes of cane for the week.

While this was above budget, total throughput was impacted by three mills having scheduled cleaning intermissions during the week.

The planned stop at Pioneer was extended following a choke on the boiler grate on restart. Crews had to manually remove a build-up of material that was impacting boiler performance.

Average weekly CCS climbed by a healthy 0.41 units this week to meet the budget of 15.0 units.

The highest CCS sample was 17.7 from a rake of Q240 plant cane in the Inkerman area.

The cane crop in the Burdekin continues to cut close to estimate and the quality of cane delivered to the mill has been good.
