Comments:

The Burdekin mills have now passed the halfway mark for the 2020 crush.

The weekly throughput of just under 390,000 tonnes of cane brought the season total to 4.31 million tonnes.

A cleaning intermission planned for Pioneer Mill next week was brought forward to complete some necessary maintenance. A scheduled clean at Inkerman was extended due to processing issues on start-up.

Average weekly CCS increased to 15.24 units after levelling out last week. Season to date CCS is now above 14.0 units.

The highest CCS sample was 18.0 from a rake of Q240 first ratoon cane in the Inkerman area.

With school holidays beginning on Friday 18 September, parents and carers are urged to warn their children of the dangers of playing near cane railway lines.
