Comments:

Close to 400,000 tonnes of cane was processed for the week, which was above budget.

Invicta Mill had a scheduled B-side clean. There were unscheduled stops at each of the other three mills, but factory performance outside these stops was good.

Average weekly CCS increased again to 15.49 units which is above budget for the week. Season to date CCS crept up to 14.14 units.

The highest CCS sample was 18.70 from a rake of Q183 plant cane in the Inkerman area.
