QSL EARLY-START ACTIVELY MANAGED POOL

Nomination period: 1 September 2020 - 31 October 2020

Minimum tonnage: 10 tonnes

- Targets the best returns by using the same pricing approach and tools as the QSL Actively Managed Pool, but extends the pricing window across 18 months
- Nominations close in the year prior to delivery

2022 QSL 2-SEASON ACTIVELY MANAGED POOL

Nomination period: 1 September 2020 - 31 October 2020

Minimum tonnage: 10 tonnes

- Targets the best returns by using the same pricing approach and tools as the QSL Actively Managed Pool, but extends the pricing window across 2 seasons
- Prices 2022-Season sugar, with nominations closing 2 years prior to delivery

2023 QSL 3-SEASON ACTIVELY MANAGED POOL

Nomination period: 1 September 2020 - 31 October 2020

Minimum tonnage: 10 tonnes

- Targets the best returns by using the same pricing approach and tools as the QSL Actively Managed Pool, but extends the pricing window across 3 seasons
- Prices 2023-Season sugar, with nominations closing 3 years prior to delivery

Advance rate increase ahead


The QSL 2020-Season Advance Rate rises to 70% next week.

This rate increase will apply for payments made from 14 October 2020 and will be based on QSL pool values and grower-managed pricing results as of 25 September 2020.

Growers using the QSL Direct cash flow forecaster should note that pool values have recently been updated. Growers using the cash flow forecaster should regularly update their forecast to capture such pool and pricing variations as the season progresses. As pool values as at 25 September have now been finalised, QSL's default advance payment has also been advised.
