Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just over 315,000 tonnes this week. Throughput was below budget due to storms disrupting harvesting last weekend.

Most of the heavy falls were in the Pioneer and Invicta areas. As a result, a large amount of stale cane has had to be processed, causing lost time and reduced rates.

Inkerman and Kalamia mills were impacted to a lesser degree and performed well overall.

Average weekly CCS dropped to 14.71 as a result of the rain and stale cane.

The highest CCS sample was 18.01 from rakes of Q183 first and second ratoon in the Inkerman area.

Invicta Mill is currently expected to finish the season on 15 November.
