The Burdekin mills processed just over 125,000 tonnes in the final week of crushing for 2020.

Inkerman and Pioneer mills both crushed out on Saturday morning. Inkerman finished at 2.14am Sunday with a total of 1.64 million tonnes and Pioneer at 9.52am Sunday with a total of 1.62 million tonnes.

Average weekly CCS increased to 15.0 units. The season average CCS of 14.60 units finished slightly above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 18.35 from a rake of Q208 third ration cane in the Inkerman area.

I would like to thank everyone in the growing, harvesting, transport and milling sectors for the hard work that went into getting this year's crop off.
