Annual maintenance shutdown

A reminder to open water irrigators that LBW's annual shutdown period occurs in June each year. Customers who grow crops other than cane, need to be aware of the unavailability of open water during this period. LBW's annual maintenance shutdown period is determined by Sunwater's annual shutdown period, as water releases from the Burdekin Falls Dam is ceased during this time. Sunwater's annual shutdown period usually coincides with the start of the crushing season.
