State of play after today's showers: (BOM forecast 40% chance of 0-1mm)

Inkerman recorded falls up to 73 mm. They have cane until about 9pm this evening. Only 2 harvesters are cutting today after the rain, they will finish this afternoon and this cane will catch on tonight. As there will ne no cane in bins tomorrow harvesters have been advised that there will be no cutting tomorrow until the situation has been assessed. There will still be about 4K tonnes left burnt and we will hve to assess a strategy for this tomorrow.

Kalamia recorded around the 10mm mark. They have cane until about 6am tomorrow. Harvesters are confident that they will be cutting tomorrow. Logistics are expecting a 3-4 hour gap

Pioneer recorded between 5-15mm in the area. They have cane until about midnight and are confident they will load the bin fleet tomorrow. Restart expected between 12 and 1pm.

Invicta recorded some showers but they had no effect. Business as usual.

Will update tomorrow when I have more information. Above plans are dependent on no more rain.
