Comments:

The Burdekin mills have passed the 50 per cent milestone for the 2021 crush, with just under 4M tonnes processed.

The mills crushed just under 390,000 tonnes of cane for week 11. This was again above budget despite Kalamia, Pioneer and Invicta B side having cleaning stops during the week.

Cane continues to be transferred out of the Inkerman area to Pioneer and Invicta mills for processing.

Average weekly CCS was 15.00 which is still trending above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 18.3 from a rake of Q240 third ration in the Pioneer Mill area.
