Comments:

Good throughput saw just under 415,000 tonnes of cane crushed for the week. This was the second-highest weekly crushing total for the year. Invicta recorded its highest weekly throughput for the year.

Inkerman has passed the milestone of one million tonnes crushed for the season – joining Pioneer and Kalamia while Invicta has crushed just over two million tonnes.

Ground conditions are improving, however, some groups are still reporting very wet patches, which have led to bogged machinery in some cases.

The average weekly CCS of 14.85 was still below budget, due to the effects of the wet conditions, but starting to improve.

The highest CCS sample was 18.0 from a rake of Q240 fourth ration in the Inkerman Mill area.

With one more week left in the school holidays, parents and carers are asked to continue to remind children of the dangers of playing near rail lines.
