Comments:

Throughput this week was just under 385,000 tonnes. This was well above budget, despite unplanned stops at Kalamia and Invicta mills through the week.

Inkerman Mill's weekly throughput of 85,640 tonnes was the second highest throughput for the season to date.

The Burdekin mills have now processed more than 6.4M tonnes, which represents more than 80 per cent of the total estimated crop.

With current mill performance and no wet weather, crushing should wrap up in the second and third weeks of November.

The average weekly CCS was 14.71 which was up on the previous week, but still below budget.

The highest CCS sample was 17.2 from a rake of Q208 third ratoon and Q232 second ratoon in the Invicta Mill area.
