## Comments:

Throughput this week was just under 360,000 tonnes. While still above budget, throughput was impacted by unplanned stops at all sites.

The Burdekin mills have now processed just under 6.8M tonnes, which represents more than 86 per cent of the total estimated crop.

Based on forecast factory throughputs and no further rain disruptions, the last day of harvesting at Invicta, Kalamia and Pioneer mills will be 9 November, with Inkerman following on 20 November.

The average weekly CCS continues to trend below budget at 14.27.

The highest CCS sample was 17.2 from a rake of Q183 second ration in the Inkerman Mill area.

With less than a month remaining until the forecast end of crushing, please continue to take care around our cane rail network.
