Fertiliser season launched in Burdekin

The team from Wilmar AgServices brought the fertiliser Season Launch back to the Burdekin last week, after a two-year pause due to the COVID-10 pandemic.

The grower meeting was held at the Burdekin's Queens Hotel on Tuesday, 5 April.

AgServices Business Manager George Russell said the event was one of seven being held across the Burdekin, Proserpine and Mackay regions in the lead-up to this year's peak fertilising season.

He said the Season Launch events were an important opportunity to provide farmers with the latest information on crop nutrition and fertiliser management.
