WILMAR CSA UPDATE

Subject: Changes to Schedule 1 of the CSA

Good afternoon

Wilmar is streamlining the online process that growers use to change the details contained in Schedule 1 of their CSA. Growers will no longer need to sign a new CSA every time they change GEIM nominations, expected area of supply or nominated tonnes.

Once a grower's nominations have been entered and validated in growerweb a new version of Schedule 1 will be created. The details in the new Schedule 1 will supersede any previous version of Schedule 1, including the version in the signed CSA. The new Schedule 1 will be in a separate file which will be available in the "My ABN Documents" section of the Growerweb alongside a copy of the CSA.

Growers will still need to sign a new CSA if:

- 1. they are a new grower entity which has not signed a CSA
- 2. they change CCS pools (CSA Opt Out)
- 3. new CSA terms have been agreed by their bargaining representative

This changes will be put into production on 19 January 2023. A mailchimp email will be sent to all growers in the week prior to advise them of the change.
